

Simple Present Tense Negative | Exercises with answers

Exercise 3

Put the verb in bold in the negative form (you can use the contracted form - ex: isn't, doesn't...):

Ex: Sam writes letters. → Sam **doesn't write** letters. OR: Sam **does not write** letters.

1. We **go** to the cinema every Friday. → We to the cinema every Friday.
2. You **read** the newspaper every day. → You the newspaper every day.
3. He **goes** to school in France. → He to school in France.
4. I **have** a shower in the morning. → I a shower in the morning.
5. She **drinks** tea every afternoon. → She tea every afternoon.
6. They **visit** their friends during the weekend. → They their friends during the weekend.
7. You **study** English very often. → You English very often.
8. It **rains** here in the summer. → It here in the summer.
9. He **likes** spinach. → He spinach.
10. She **plays** the guitar. → She the guitar.
